Travel arrangements will be made by Minerva Chihuahua (Minerva.chihuahua@utsouthwestern.edu). Students are expected to take a 3- to 5-minute taxi ride or hotel shuttle ride from Dallas Love Field to the hotel. Instructions will be included in an email once flights are arranged.

Ground Transportation

Parking permits for both the University and hotel will be provided for students driving to the site. The hotel has a shuttle that runs 4 times every morning and 4 times every afternoon to transport students to/from UT Southwestern. The hotel is ~ 1 mile from the school so it is walkable, but we have ample transportation.
